## Pattern Union - Sarah Pondevie

Sarah and Sue Stoney will be talking about fit issues for home sewists and how Sarah tries to resolve them as a designer. Examples include cup sizes for tops, and the introduction of her T-body fit system for trousers, which has sizing according to body type - because if you have extreme proportions, then grading between sizes will not create a good fit. The video shows Sue and Sarah wearing her Hannah Culottes pattern in the same fabric made according to their body types.

They demonstrate that style is more about working with your body type and getting a good fit, rather than assuming a style will not suit you.

Sarah created **Pattern Union** as an off shoot of Workspace Fashion and Design School, as a way of reaching more people. She is a teacher and maker of fashion, with a passion for pattern making. Her years of working in made-to-measure clothing and teaching has given her the breadth of knowledge to create a range of clothing patterns that appreciates the fact that traditional sizing does not reflect standard measurements.

Pattern Union offers the home sewer a new approach to fitting and designing clothes. The manifesto 'Fit, form and function, without compromising style' encompasses the ethos of Sarah's brand, which is to enable fit alterations that assume not all bodies are the same, and provide the tools required to easily adapt to the individual.
